Motion Kielman, Brooks to approve and adopt the items contained in the Consent Agenda and Minutes (07-06-2023) Ayes: Doty, Sherburne, Kielman, Brooks and Lodge. Nays: None. Absent: None. MC.

Department Head Reports as follows: Fire Department: None, Am-

bulance: None. Police Chief Mackey gave a report with total number of calls in June at 150 for police service. Library Update from Kristen Clark including current and upcoming programs available, as well as the number of patrons utilizing both in person services and online. Library budget and Board of trustees were discussed by Toenjes and Neal.

Brooks to provide updates on building inspections on Main Street and commercial properties having rentals in them. Hilton to put a tent up beginning August 6 for approximately 4 weeks. A concerned citizen spoke up about the increase in traffic, cars parking on homeowners lawns. Council denied the request.
